IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION POLICY

All of our program registration is completed electronically through our website, ConcordRec.MyRec.com. Registration may also be done in person or over the phone at the Hunt Recreation Center or the Beede Swim & Fitness Center. In order to be processed, full payment must accompany the registration. Beede Memberships must be active at the time of registration to receive the "member rate".

CANCELLATION POLICY

There will be a \$35.00 fee if you must cancel or switch a class or activity once your registration has been processed. The cancellation/change fee* applies to **each activity/program** that needs to be altered. This applies to all Concord Recreation programs including membership at the Beede Swim and Fitness Center. Concord Recreation reserves the right to make schedule changes to better serve our members or to cancel/combine instructional classes and programs due to insufficient enrollment.

A full or partial refund will be issued under the program participants name or a make-up will be scheduled if Concord Recreation must cancel a class due to the following:

- Weather (Snow/Blizzard, Tornado, Hurricane, etc.)
- Mechanical issues
- Fire evacuation
- A documented medical illness that prevents participation in the program
- Power outages
- No water supply
- Town wide health emergency or closure

***A participant must request a cancellation at least 10 business days before the program starts to receive refund (minus fee).**

**Please note that Summer Camp, AfterSchool, BeforeSchool, Early Release at Hunt and Concord Carousel Preschool are excluded and have separate cancellation/change policies outlined in their handbooks. Please refer to those handbooks for those cancellation policies.*

No refunds or makeups will be issued for circumstances including, but not limited to:

- If you should choose not to attend for any reason (outside of a documented medical illness)
- If cancellation notice is provided less than 10 business days before the program starts.

If Concord Recreation decides to cancel a program for any reason, we will notify you of the decision to refund, partially refund, or schedule a make up class. All situations outside of the ones mentioned above will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Town of Concord, MA is committed to making its Recreation Department programs and activities available to as many citizens as possible. This financial assistance program has been established to meet the needs of individuals and families who have limited financial resources. All Concord residents and students who attend any Concord Public School are eligible to apply. Concord Recreation follows the national poverty guidelines when determining awards.

Concord Recreation reserves the right to exercise managerial discretion regarding financial assistance, and to limit the amount of funding allocated to any given household or individual within one tax year.

We welcome kids and adults of all ages and abilities to participate in any of our Concord Recreation programs. To help visually identify programs that are specifically designed for participants with disabilities, please look for this inclusion logo throughout the brochure.

- *If a program is notated as an adaptive program, we still welcome participants WITHOUT disabilities to participate. Siblings, aides and classmates welcome!*
- *As a Department, we acknowledge that the experience that takes place within these identified classes are open to different learning styles and accommodations. These classes will typically have fewer participants, more breaks, and visual schedules, when possible.*
- *As a Department, we ask parents to be proactive upon registration in identifying that their child may need extra help. To assure we are prepared to work with your child and to effectively manage the program as a whole, you will be asked to fill out an intake assessment.*

HOW TO READ FOOD LABELS WITH CONFIDENCE

WHEN: April

Learn how to cut through food marketing claims and understand what really matters on nutrition labels. This interactive workshop focuses on spotting protein, fiber, added sugars, and misleading language so you can make confident, informed choices at the grocery store.

LAND WORKOUTS

ARTHRITIS GROOVE & MOVE

The class aims to reduce fatigue, pain and stiffness associated with arthritis. Key activities include multiple exercise activities such as warm-up, range of motion/stretching, strengthening, cardiovascular endurance, and cool down.

BODY SCULPTING

Work all major muscle groups using a variety of strengthening equipment and your own body! This class is designed to build strength, increase bone density, build lean muscle while toning and shaping your body.

BOOT CAMP

This one hour class is a low impact, high intensity workout with the focus on maximum cardio benefit. We will utilize body weight and a variety of equipment and High Intensity Interval Training (HIIT) to maximize cardio, strength and balance.

CIRCUIT TRAINING

The stations are designed for you to work at your own pace, you can make the exercise hard or modify. The nice part about a circuit class is that if there is a station that doesn't work for your body you can just move on to the next one. Tight on time - no worry - run in and hit as many circuits as you have time for. All levels welcome!

PILATES WITH WEIGHTS

Classical Pilates with small hand weights to sculpt upper body and lower body, as well as abs, finishing with deep stretch.

TABATA SPIN BOOTCAMP

Get ready for a combination cardio and strength training class to get your day started. Spin for 25min, then get off your bike for 25 min of tabata strength training using mostly dumbbells and body weight exercises and end with a 5-10min full body cooldown stretch. Appropriate for all levels, modifications will be shown as needed.

YOGA

You will be led through yoga poses that encourage balance, strength and lots of stretching and deep breathing to get those stiff muscles relaxed! This class is for men and women and anyone who wants more movement in their lives. All are welcome!

DIVE WELL

DEEP CARDIO HIIT (HIGH INTENSITY INTERVAL TRAINING)

This class introduces exercise conducted while suspended in the deep, alternating between bursts of high intensity output and moderate activity intervals. Participants exercise all muscle groups using the resistance and buoyancy of water and the resistance of their hand weights.

S'WET™ DEEP

S'WET™ is a high-intensity, low-impact cardio and strength training program that will get your heart racing and your blood pumping!

DEEP CARDIO BOOT CAMP

Get ready to improve your strength and endurance in this fast paced class! This workout is for intermediate to advanced participants.

SHALLOW END - LAP POOL

AQUA CARDIO BLAST

This high energy, powerful and uplifting class is a fun and effective way to burn calories and build muscles. With a combination of basic martial arts this high intensity class is great for cardiovascular fitness, coordination, muscle control and flexibility. All levels are welcomed!

SHALLOW CARDIO HIIT

This high energy class will increase muscular endurance and improve cardio-respiratory endurance by utilizing the resistance of water. Shorter periods of high intensity intervals will be alternated with lower intensity intervals. In less time than a traditional steady state workout, you will burn more calories and continue to burn more calories long after the workout has ended.

WARM WATER POOL

ARTHRITIS

This water exercise program helps to reduce arthritis pain and stiffness while keeping joints flexible and muscles strong. The water provides gentle resistance to build muscle strength and supports joints to encourage free movement.

AI CHI

This class is a program designed to increase range of motion, mobility, and balance, as well as to reduce stress. It includes fluid movements paired with breathing techniques to lengthen, strengthen and relax the body to prepare for the day.

MASTERS SWIM

AGE: 18+ years

LOCATION: Lap Pool - Lanes 4-8

Whether you are a serious swimmer looking for a coached workout or training for a triathlon, we have the workout program for you.

Prerequisite: Prior age-group, high school, club or college swimming experience. Must be technically proficient swimmer in freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke and willing to learn butterfly and flip turns.

PARENT AND CHILD

AGE: 0-4 years

LOCATION: Warm Water Pool

This American Red Cross class is designed to help children become comfortable in the aquatic environment. Parents and children will be introduced to basic skills such as entering/exiting pool safely, kicking and blowing bubbles. Skills will be taught to the parent who will work with the child at their own pace. Toys and songs will be incorporated into the learning process. Adult must participate in the water with child. Class will be capped at 10 pairs.

ADAPTIVE AQUATICS

AGE: 5-22 years

LOCATION: Warm Water Pool

In these 1:1 swim lessons, participants will work with American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors and a group of specially trained volunteers. All program and pool staff are certified in ARC Lifeguard Training, CPR, AED and First Aid.

BEGINNER

Focus will be on participant's ability in the water as well as emphasis on safety, having fun, social interaction and developing positive self-image through successful participation.

INTERMEDIATE

Prerequisite: Participant must be able to safely swim 25 yards in 7 feet of water. Freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke will be developed and butterfly will be introduced. Participants will work on technique and endurance throughout this class as well as increase their level of physical fitness.

PRESCHOOL AQUATICS

GRADE: 3-5 years

LOCATION: Warm Water Pool

LEVEL 1

Participants work towards basic skills, including body positions, blowing bubbles, submerging, floating, kicking and arm action, and jumping all done with support.

LEVEL 2

Continues to reinforce basic skills moving towards little or no assistance. Emphasis is placed on floating, arm and leg action, and an introduction to rhythmic breathing.

Prerequisite: Child must be able to perform 5 rhythmic bobs and be comfortable with submerging.

LEVEL 3

Class will work on the skills necessary to enter into the American Red Cross level classes. Skills include independent floating, and front and back crawl strokes.

Prerequisite: Must have successfully completed Preschool 1 and 2. Must be able to swim one length of the Warm Water Pool unassisted.

YOUTH SWIM LESSONS

GRADE: K and Up

LOCATION: Shallow End

Levels 2-6 **Prerequisite:** Must have successfully completed the previous level.

LEVEL 1

Introduction to Water Skills: Students will learn how to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.

LEVEL 2

Fundamentals of Aquatic Skills: Children will earn basic swimming skills.

LEVEL 3

Stroke Development: Children will earn basic swimming skills.

LEVEL 4

Stroke Improvement: Students will gain confidence during swim lesson, improve their stroke and gain additional aquatic skills.

LEVEL 5

Stroke Refinement: Guidance allows children to refine their strokes and become more efficient swimmers.

LEVEL 6

Swimming and Skill Proficiency: Students will learn to swim with ease and efficiency and gain the ability to swim smoothly over greater distances.

OTTERS SWIM CLUB

Our recreational swim club is designed to provide a positive team environment for learning good sportsmanship through competitive swimming. Otters begin with the fundamental skills and we build from there to allow each swimmer to achieve their individual goals. Our Otters Club is an inclusive community and we provide a safe and healthy environment for all of our swimmers to begin a life-long love of swimming.

JUNIOR OTTERS

Designed for swimmers who are interested in swimming laps to improve their strokes with the goal of making the swimmers ready to swim for a competitive team. Practices will focus on improving technique, speed, and endurance.

Please note that practices do not happen during holidays.

Concord Carousel Preschool offers full and half day program with extended morning options. We offer a small, creative learning environment for children ages 2 years and 9 months – 5 years old. We offer 3, 4 and 5 day programs based on age from 9am until 12 or 5pm with extended mornings at 8am, and Stay and Play until 2:30pm, for an additional cost. We aim to deliver a nurturing and quality preschool experience for our children and their families. Our developmental curriculum is designed to promote physical, social, emotional and cognitive growth by presenting challenges and engaging children in meaningful activities. Problem solving, creativity and learning are stimulated through both spontaneous and structured activities. Integrated play activities encourage children to interact with their peers, their teachers and materials.



The **Before School Program** provides care for children grades K-5 in the morning before the start of the school day from 7:30am-9:00am in each of the elementary schools. The children have the opportunity to prepare for their school day in a comfortable social setting. Children have time to play games, finish homework, read and play outdoors. Before School does not operate on days when school is not in session or when there is a delayed opening for the school.

The **AfterSchool Program** provides care for children in grades K-5 every day in each of the three elementary schools (from 3:20pm-6:00pm) each day and 12:20pm-6:00pm on Early Release days. A two-day minimum is required for our program. The daily schedule at each site includes supervised indoor and (lots of) outdoor play. Activities are based on children's interests and each day includes a short homework/reading period. We follow the Concord School calendar and do not provide care on days that school is not in session. Concord Recreation often provides alternative programming on these days.

Our **Early Release Day Program** is for those families only needing care on Concord's weekly early release day for grades K-5. (Families who are part of the AfterSchool Program do not need to sign up for this program but instead sign up for the early release day as one of their AfterSchool days). The children are bused from each of the three elementary schools to the Hunt Recreation Center for this program and pick up is by 6:00pm. Our daily schedule includes lots of outdoor play as well as indoor play, arts and crafts, science activities and time for socializing.



All of our Childcare Services Programs across all age groups value diversity and are committed to creating welcoming childcare settings. Our programs welcome families and children with a wide variety of experiences, identifications and abilities, along with a variety of racial, ethnic, family, religious, economic and cultural backgrounds. We work to instill a genuine appreciation of and respect for others. By appreciating individual differences, we encourage children and their families to value the richness and importance of a diverse community and to support a culture of belonging.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Children must be 2 years, 9 months by September 8, 2025 to attend Carousel Preschool at the beginning of the school year. Carousel has a rolling admission policy allowing children to register mid-year as long as space is available.

Fees are based on a full school year tuition and are divided into 10 equal monthly installments. The tuition is based on the cost of providing a program of high quality, with a highly qualified licensed staff, on a self-supporting basis without tax support.

CANCELLATION/CHANGE POLICY

- Once registered any changes will be charged a \$35 change fee per child.
- If you need to withdraw there will be a \$75 cancellation fee.
- Any request to change/cancel must be made by the 7th of the prior month to not be charged fully for the next month.
- August/September change requests or withdrawals must be received by received by **July 17** or change will be delayed to October 1.

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING (CIT) GRADES: ENTERING 9-10*

This program combines work, recreation, and employment training all in the role of working with children. Participants will assist Camp Three Rivers Counselors while being monitored and supported. The CIT program offers two weekly workshops including team building, safety training, first aid and communication skills.

*The program will operate on a two week consecutive basis.

ARTS AND REC GRADES: ENTERING K-6*

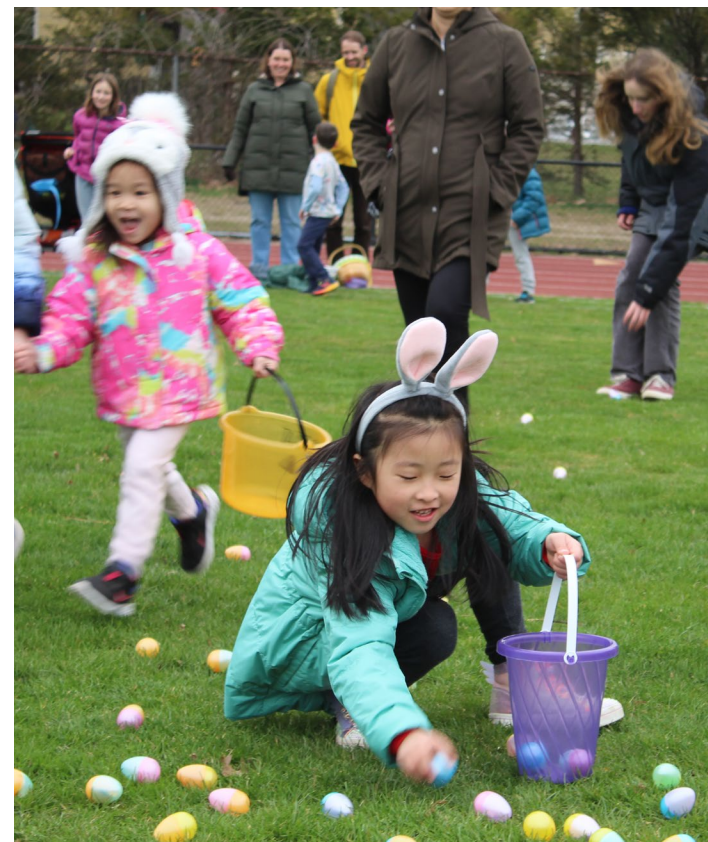
